The term "youth mental health" might bring to mind teens struggling with depression or anxiety—but children as young as five years old are experiencing mental health challenges. One in six U.S. children between the ages of 2 and 8 <u>has a diagnosed mental disorder</u>.

At One Place, we provide early education programs that support children's healthy social-emotional development during the first 2,000 days of life when critical brain development occurs.


