Strengthening Children:

Early experiences matter, they mold and shape the developing brain and lay the foundation for a child's sound mental health. We provide early education programs that support children's healthy development during the first 2,000 days when critical brain development occurs.

Connecting Families:

We connect families and children to helpful resources – from finding the right child care program to helping military families access resources and thrive in Onslow County. With these services, families become confident, empowered, and engaged with their community.

Ending Child Abuse:

All of our programs are designed to serve as protective factors for children and families. When children are hurt through abuse or neglect, our Child Advocacy Center provides hope and healing through individualized services.





We do this through services like our:

Early Education Programs such as Early Head Start, Three School, and NC Pre-K that prepare children for future learning success, support their social-emotional development and encourage family engagement.

Child Care Resource and Referral which is a hub of information for children and families to access affordable, high-quality child care and connect to community resources.

Child Advocacy Center which provides critical services for children who are victims of abuse and neglect.

as a way to fill gaps in funding and allow our organization to meet families where they are by providing necessary services and support, regardless of funding restrictions.

Funds raised at this event help us operate and promote the sustainability of services for years to come. More About Our Work

Since its inception, the One Place Child Advocacy Center has brought hope and healing to more than 3,400 abused and neglected children and their families. More than 30 percent of victims are military dependents.

Each year we evaluate more than 800 children for social-emotional development and mental health concerns through early care and education programs such as Early Head Start and NC Pre-K. When challenges are identified, early intervention resources are provided to help ensure a strong social-emotional foundation for our community's children.

More than 750 parents and caregivers receive information on and referrals to high-quality child care annually through our Child Care Resource and Referral team. Families need child care so they can go to work, be productive at work, and build successful careers. When families do not have access to the child care they need, their productivity decreases and negatively impacts the overall workforce and economy in our community.

Studies show that the single most significant factor influencing a child's early educational success is an introduction to books and being read to at home before starting school. Since our partnership with Dolly Parton's Imagination Library began in 2011, more than 43,800 children in Onslow County have received books to build their home library.
